

EXTENSION OF THE ARRANGEMENT FOR THE EXCHANGE OF

BETWEEN  
THE OFFICE FOR NUCLEAR REGULATION OF

AND  
THE UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION

The Office for Nuclear Regulation of Great Britain (ONR) and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC), hereinafter "the Participants";

Recalling the Arrangement for the Exchange of Information and Co-Operation in the Area of Regulation of Safe Nuclear Energy Use for Peaceful Purposes between the Office for Nuclear Regulation of Great Britain and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, signed at Vienna, Austria, on September 17, 2013, (the Arrangement); and

Guided by their desire to continue cooperation under the Arrangement as envisaged by Paragraph 8(1)(b) of the Arrangement;

Hereby intend as follows:

1. The Participants intend to extend the Arrangement for a period of two years, from September 18, 2018, until September 18, 2020.
2. This extension becomes effective upon the signatures of both Participants.
