

THIS AGREEMENT is made on the 3rd day of April 2014 between the Secretary of State for the Department of Energy and Climate Change ("the Secretary of State") and the Office for Nuclear Regulation ("the ONR") under section 90(1) of the Energy Act 2013. It relates to the functions that the ONR agrees to perform on behalf of the Secretary of State. Those functions are functions that in the opinion of the Secretary of State for Work and Pensions can appropriately be performed by the ONR.

IT IS AGREED THAT:


1. The ONR will perform the functions set out in the Schedule on behalf of the Secretary of State.
2. This Agreement will come into effect on the 3rd April 2014. It will terminate on the expiry of three months written notice of termination given by either party to the Agreement to the other party.

Functions to be performed by the ONR on behalf of the Secretary of State

Part 1: Statutory Functions

Energy Act 2004 (c.20)

1. Such of the Secretary of State's functions under the following provisions of paragraph 2 of Schedule 13 set out below (which relate to giving directions to the Civil Nuclear Police Authority and undertaking consultation):
 - (a) sub-paragraph (1)(e) for the purposes of giving directions regarding vetting and personnel security of members of the Constabulary and other employees of the Police Authority , and in relation to their appointment as such; and
 - (b) sub-paragraph 3 for the purposes of consultation on directions regarding vetting and personnel security.
2. Such of the Secretary of State's functions under section 63(3) (which relates to the receipt of money) relating to anything done under those provisions of Schedule 13 for the purposes set out above, or to the performance of the Secretary of State's non statutory functions set out below.

Part 2: Non-statutory functions

1. The Secretary of State's function of providing independent advice on the effectiveness of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary's operational delivery of the defence of nuclear material and other radioactive material, both in transit and at civil nuclear sites and to the protection of sensitive nuclear information.
