Closure of Regulatory Observation RO-ABWR-0036, Demonstration that the Approach taken to Radioactive Waste Management Reduces Risks so far as is Reasonably Practicable (SFAIRP)

I refer to Regulatory Observation RO-ABWR-0036 issued on 16th January 2015.

I confirm that:

- Hitachi-GE has submitted the information committed to within its Resolution Plan.
- Hitachi-GE has demonstrated the adoption of an appropriately scoped GDA ALARP Methodology and its application to all the UK ABWR radioactive waste management systems in a proportionate manner that aligned with the hazards present in each system and the status of the designs within GDA.
- This information has been reviewed by ONR and I judge that it provides an adequate response to the Regulatory Observation.

Based on my assessment, Hitachi-GE has provided sufficient evidence to meet the intent of RO-ABWR-0036 and addressed the issues which led to the RO being raised. The Assessment Findings identified in the GDA UK ABWR Step 4 Assessment Report for the Management of Radioactive Wastes (ONR-NR-AR-17-025) capture residual matters which will need to be resolved by a future licensee.

On this basis, ONR confirms the closure of Regulatory Observation RO-ABWR-0036.
