# 1. Welcome to the ONR QNFLO Reporting Templates

- ONR have developed a suite of Excel templates to assist its QNFLO DutyHolders in creation of the following reports in XML format, as required under the NSR19 Regulations
  - Inventory Change Report (ICR)
  - Physical Inventory Listing Report (PIL)
  - Material Balance Report (MBR)
- 2. These are Excel macro-enabled templates which will need to be "trusted" by your organisation before use
- 3. The following documentation is intended for the DutyHolder to understand the latest release, and to perform any technical activities required for template implementation & rollout.

# **Pilot Programme**

4. The QNFLO Templates are currently under Pilot. We are grateful for your and your users' assistance in testing the templates, reviewing the documentation and working through any technical issues.

#### **Release Note**

5. Please see Appendix B for more details around the current release

- 1. The templates are provided by ONR on the following terms
- 2. Please see the accompanying User Guide for issues & assumptions affecting adoption & use of the Templates by your organisation. In particular, please note that:

    - i. the accuracy & timeliness of reports
    - ii. the quality of data submitted; and
    - iii. the access & retention of all data under secure conditions
  - b. The DutyHolder is responsible for virus-checking of the templates before use or transmission.
  - c. ONR cannot be held responsible for any issues arising out of implementing or using the Templates.
- 3. The Templates are ONR Copyright. You may copy & distribute them for internal use only. Please do not distribute them outside of your organisation.
  - Please refer any prospective new users to the ONR QNFLO Helpdesk, where we will be happy to help.
- 4. You are not permitted to remove any passwords or protections on the templates, or to modify any template code.

## 3. Pre-Requisites before Internal Release

# **Minimum Technical Requirements**

- 1. The Templates are "Excel Macro-Enabled Workbooks" (file suffix ".xlsm"), developed in Microsoft Excel 365 (Version 2202 Build 16, 64-bit) and should run in any MS Excel 365 environment under Windows 7 or above
- 2. The associated documentation is in PDF-format and requires a PDF-reader capability
- The Templates can usually only be opened and used where they have been "trusted" by the user's
  organisation. Please see Appendix A which deals with issues around establishing trust of our "ONR Code
  Signing Certificate".

## **Secure Operations**

4. Please ensure that your organisation is aware of and has mitigated the security risks around (a) the handling and transmission of Sensitive Nuclear Information, and (b) more generally around data security & hygiene

#### **Other Business Requirements**

5. Please see the User Guide for broader business considerations around eg Nuclear Material Accountancy, familiarity & compliance with NSR19 Regulations, staff training.

# Appendix A. Trusting the ONR Macro-Enabled Templates

# A.1. Background

1. The ONR Templates are "Excel macro-enabled workbooks" (XLSM files, suffix ".xlsm"), which contain custom executable Visual Basic (VBA) code developed by ONR. Such code needs to be carefully managed by user

organisations, and XLSM files which have not been developed by your own organisation should not be trusted.

2. ONR have password protected and "signed" the VBA project within the Templates using an ONR Code-Signing Certificate.

We provide a version of that certificate to the QNFLO DutyHolder organisation for installation as a Trusted Certificate when opening & using the ONR Templates in MS Excel.

This Certificate therefore gives you the capability to trust & use the templates – in theory

- 3. In practice, the implementation of such trust can be complex, eg
  - An organisation which has never trusted any such document may need to open up their current security model sufficiently to permit any trust
  - The certificate used is for Basic Code Signing. There are other variant forms of Microsoft trust & security which we may need to support
  - Other organisations may have insufficient security and this implementation has revealed that they should tighten up.
- 4. We will try to help organisations adapt to these various challenges, and to adapt our own approach as required

### A.2. Pre-Requisites

- 1. Our initial assumptions are that:
  - a. the organisation is willing and able to trust the ONR templates
  - b. there are nominated information and network security professionals within each DutyHolder organisation who understand their technical configuration and the issues involved, and have the capability & permission to implement the necessary changes

## A.3. The Code Signing Certificate

1. ONR has signed the template workbooks with following certificate:

- 2. ONR are providing a Public version of the certificate only, for Trust purposes
- 3. The certificate is for Basic Code Signing, as opposed to Microsoft Enhanced (EV) Validation
- 4. The certificate has been limited to 1 year we will extend subject to success of the pilot programme
- 5. We assume you have the DigiCert root certificate as already trusted within
- 6. The certificate includes the "intermediate certificates" which fill in the certificate hierarchy between the DigitCert Root & the ONR Code Signing certs.

## A.4. Configure Excel Trust

- The Excel Trust Centre governs the overall approach to macro-enabled workbooks and whether certificates are even considered
- 2. More information is available here:
  - Enable or disable macros in Office files (microsoft.com)
- 3. Your organisation will configure the overall behaviour of Excel Trust Centre using settings within Office 365 Please consult your IT Security team for your organisational policies & approach..
- 4. Once you are able to trust any macro-enabled workbook, you should see that "Disable all macros except digitally signed macros" is the available option in the trust centre.
  - If currently unselected then please select, save & exit

#### A.5. Install the Certificate

### 1. Prepare the Certificate File

- 1. Using notepad, create a new text file with the name "onr-simrs-qnflo-csr-4096-20221012.txt"
- 2. Copy the following text into the file, then save & close
